## Fund-raisers at marathon given awards

**Mumbai:** Governor Bhagat Singh Koshiyari on Tuesday presented the Tata Mumbai Marathon Philanthropy Awards to some of the highest fund-raisers this year. Breaking its previous records, the race participants raised Rs 45.9 crore through NGO United Way Mumbai for charity this year.

The highest fund-raiser this year was the late Dhaval Mehta, who died in a road accident a little before the race. He raised Rs 2.4 crore for the NGO Shri-mad Rajchandra Love and Care.

A close second was V S Parthasarathy, CEO, Mahindra Mobilities, who raised Rs 2.2 crore for the KC Mahindra Education Trust. Three other individuals raised over Rs 1 crore each.

“The impact of the Tata Mumbai Marathon resonates beyond race day,” governor Koshiyari said. TNN
